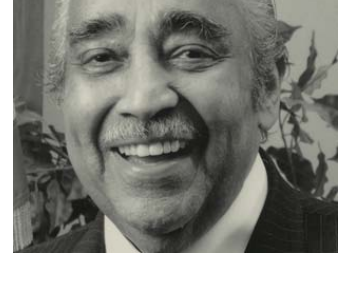

For his service and contributions to the Harlem community, its local residents, public schools, police departments, community-based organizations, and to Harlem Hospital Center.

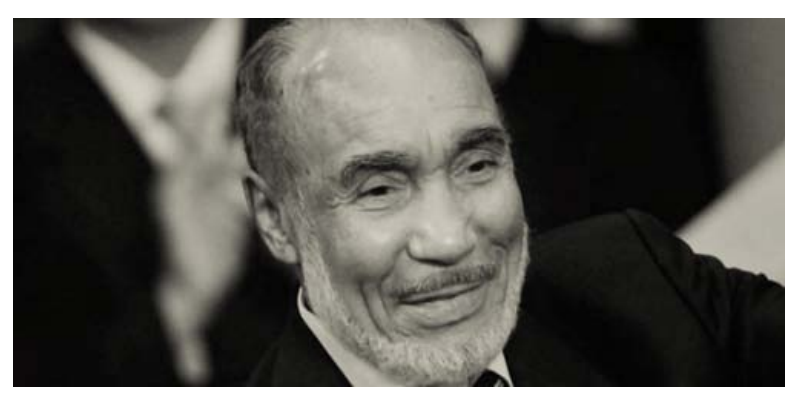


DR. LISA A. ROSS, MD, MBA
