

HHS Accelerator System Overview: Introduction

- The HHS Accelerator System was launched to simplify and improve the competitive contract process for health and human services providers.
- Agencies publish all Request for Proposals (RFPs) in the HHS Accelerator System.
- Prequalified providers approved for relevant Services are "Eligible to Propose" and submit proposals through the HHS Accelerator System after procurements are released.
- Agencies receive and evaluate proposals in Accelerator then award Contracts through the System.
- Accelerator Financials is being phased in and will enable Agencies and vendors to manage budgets, invoices and payments.







Eligibility to compete determined through a two-part prequalification Application.




Business Application




