Procurement Title:	Universal Pre-Kindergarten Services (Open-Ended)

Procurement Description:	<p>The New York City Department of Education (NYCDOE) intends to conduct an innovative procurement through the release of an open-ended solicitation seeking proposals for the provision of Full-Day Universal Pre-Kindergarten (UPK) services to four-year-olds. Vendors will be required to provide a consistent weekly schedule for 31 hours and 40 minutes per week, at least five days per week, for 180 days of the school year.</p> <p>To meet the UPK expansion goals, the Request for Proposals (RFP) will remain open for an indefinite period. The NYCDOE will only review and consider proposals for areas where current needs for full day Universal pre-Kindergarten have not been fully met. In such cases, proposals will be reviewed by the NYCDOE as they are received, and contracts will be awarded on an ongoing basis, until the NYCDOE determines that all community needs for UPK service delivery has been met. Proposals received in response to this open ended RFP will be evaluated based on criteria that will be articulated in the solicitation.</p> <p>All interested applicants who are considering submitting a proposal, but do not have a site secured should search the Pre-Kindergarten Space Registry. This registry allows potential pre-K operators to search a database of available spaces and contact space holders.
