For charter schools to eligible, they must have a regular dismissal time of 3 p.m. and lack a comprehensive arschool program. e new programs will operate for 15 hours per week during the school year for a total 540 hours annually. At least 9 hours per week will be devoted to structured, goal- ented programming, with the remaining 6 hours being available for drop-in activities. the total 540 hours, 216 hours of activities may be unstructured and offered during school week or on school closing days. All programs will provide academic 'chment, leadership development and physical activity. Providers will work in close laboration with the host school to recruit and retain struggling students, enhance the gram design, and align structured activities with school-day learning. Schools, in n, will make in-kind contributions to the programs, such as teacher time and ricular resources, in addition to providing classroom space and access to school ilities such as the gymnasium, computer labs and library. e procurement for the OST Middle School Expansion initiative will be organized into solicitations, one for each school distr
