Procurement Description:	<p>This procurement is intended to identify eligible high-quality early childhood providers who are willing to collaborate with the Division of Early Childhood Education (DECE) to implement the Universal Prekindergarten (UPK) Program in New York City with a need for prekindergarten seats. This procurement is open to providers serving any of New York City's 32 community school districts. DOE seeks vendors who can provide a consistent weekly schedule for a full-day program. No individual UPK day can exceed 7 hours. Priority will be given to qualified providers proposing to offer full-day seats in areas where sufficient demand for additional full-day seats has been identified, as determined by the DECE. Awards will be made to providers that demonstrate the ability to meet programmatic quality and operational expectations, objectives and regulations set forth by the New York State Education Department and New York City Department of Education's Division of Early Childhood Education.</p> <p>The procurement value and number of contracts are to be determined.</p>
