Procurement Description:	<p>New York City Human Resources Administration (HRA) is seeking up to five (5) qualified vendors to provide services for the Case Management Support Program (CMS Program).</p> <p>With the CMS Program, CAS seeks to expand the populations reached by HRA's current Comprehensive Services Management contract, and enhance and increase the scope of services that are available. New York City is re-orienting its services citywide and the CMS Program will provide supportive case management services to those that require the greatest assistance to connect to, and maintain compliance with, HRA services due to multiple factors including substance use disorders, recurring homelessness, severe mental illness or other complicating behavioral health issues. Notwithstanding, these clients may not be eligible for case management services provided by HRA's existing programs, and/or existing HRA programs that cannot meet the complex and immediate needs of these clients.
