Procurement Description:	<p>DHS considers shelters to be time-limited, emergency facilities that are available to clients who are temporarily unable to live independently due to disability, adverse life circumstances or other crises. In addition to providing safe and cost-effective room and board, shelter programs must assist clients to return to living with self-sufficiency in the community.</p> <p>Through this RFP, DHS is seeking qualified providers to operate two shelter facilities, 85 Lexington and Kenton Hall. Each shelter program will be comprised of program services and shelter operations.</p> <p>85 Lexington is a 103-bed facility in Brooklyn, NY Kenton Hall is a 108-bed facility in New York, NY. This shelter will provide a substance abuse treatment program with enhanced services, including mental health, employment and housing assistance for homeless single men.</p> <p>Proposers may propose to operate more than one shelter facility. However, a complete and separate proposal must be submitted for each shelter facility proposed.</p>
