

Pre-K Admissions Overview & Supports

On April 2, 2014, Mayor de Blasio announced the expansion of high quality full-day pre-kindergarten for children and families across our City. We are pleased to be able to offer families diverse options and look forward to announcing thousands more seats in the coming months.

Please note: Pre-K Expansion flyers are now available (in <u>Arabic</u>, <u>Bengali</u>, <u>Chinese</u>, <u>French</u>, <u>Haitian Creole</u>, <u>Korean</u>, <u>Russian</u>, <u>Spanish</u>, and <u>Urdu</u>). Please share with families to alert them about the new full-day pre-k options.

Pre-K Basics

- **Eligibility:** Children who turn four years of age by December 31, 2014 (children born in 2010) and live in any of the five Boroughs are eligible for free pre-kindergarten starting September 2014.
- **Pre-K Settings:** Pre-K is offered in public schools and community-based organizations (CBOs) (e.g. Day Care Centers, Head Start programs, Group Family Day Care, Independent Schools, Parochial Schools, etc.). All New York City pre-kindergarten programs share a common goal: to prepare children for school and life by giving them a solid foundation.

Finding a Pre-K Program

- Families can refer to the Pre-K Directory for a list of Public School and CBO programs.
- For a list of where new full-day pre-k seats were added, families must review the Pre-K Expansion Guide.
- The Directory and the Expansion Guide are translated into 9 languages on the nyc.gov/schools/prek website.

Applying to Pre-K

- Public School Pre-K: Families must submit an application online or at a Borough Enrollment Office by Wednesday, April 23, 2014. <u>Translated step-by-step instructions</u> are available in 9 languages (<u>Arabic, Bengali, Chinese, French, Haitian Creole, Korean, Russian, Spanish, and Urdu</u>). There is an instance of the online application tool in Spanish.
- **CBO Pre-K:** CBOs manage their own admissions process. Families must submit a <u>CBO application</u> (available in <u>Arabic</u>, <u>Bengali</u>, <u>Chinese</u>, <u>French</u>, <u>Haitian Creole</u>, <u>Korean</u>, <u>Russian</u>, <u>Spanish</u>, and <u>Urdu</u>) directly to each CBO of interest.
