

NYC Procurement Roadmap

NYC has simplified its contracting process for Client and Community Services (CCS) contracts by launching the HHS Accelerator System, which removes redundancy through a central application. An HHS Accelerator Team has also been established, and is specifically dedicated to managing the system and working with providers who do business with CCS Agencies (*list available [online](#)*).

The NYC Procurement Roadmap, which will be published Spring 2013, establishes the anticipated timeline for release of specific Requests for Proposals (RFPs) by CCS Agencies. The HHS Accelerator Team works closely with CCS Agencies and will post periodic updates to the roadmap as necessary. We invite you to use the CCS Catalog to learn more about services NYC administers and submit applications to compete in future RFPs.

Client and Community Services (CCS) Catalog

The CCS Catalog includes services NYC administers and accompanying definitions which indicate the programmatic capabilities prospective Providers should have.

How will the CCS Catalog be used in the HHS Accelerator System?

- By City Agencies to describe service capability required for upcoming RFPs
- By Providers to select the services they offer. These services will be captured in the HHS Accelerator Service Application, which is required prior to submission of proposals in response to RFPs.

We currently anticipate RFPs being released through the system late 2013-early 2014. These will be listed on the roadmap which should first be published Spring 2013. Until then, the service capabilities contained in those RFPs will be listed on this page.
