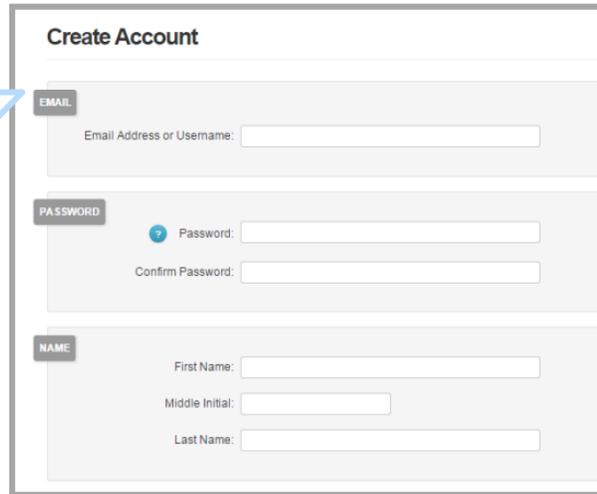

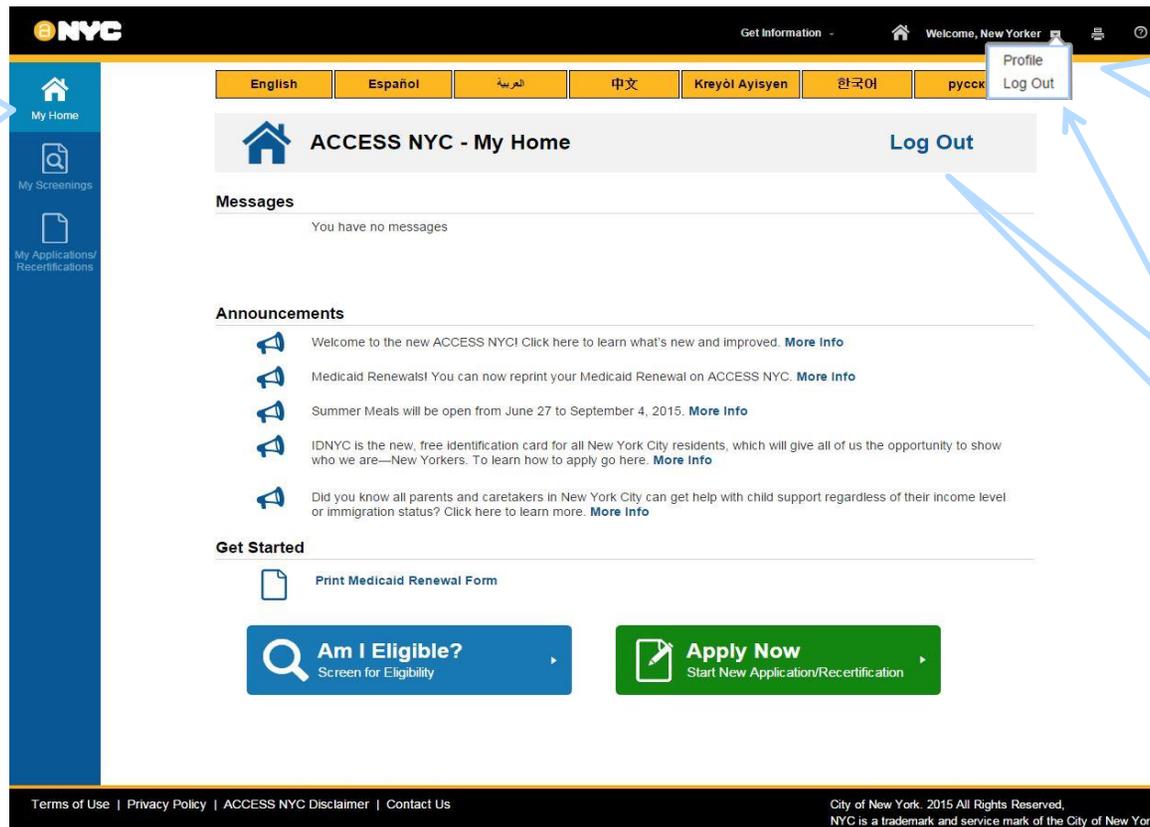
Why should I create an ACCESS NYC

account? Creating an account will allow you to save your screening information and submit applications directly online. Though you can screen for eligibility anonymously, if you create an account, you can also apply or recertify online for certain programs (such as SNAP) through ACCESS NYC.

Do I need to create an account to screen for benefits? Account Creation is NOT required to screen for the benefit programs on ACCESS NYC, but an account lets you save your eligibility information.

Apply for SNAP

Applying for SNAP is easy. Simply answer questions about your household, income, and expenses. Once completed, ACCESS NYC presents you with a summary which you can edit. If all information is correct, click “Next” to sign and submit your application. You will receive a confirmation number and next steps in the application process.

Recertify SNAP

Recertify your current Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) case online through ACCESS NYC. Information from your current case will be pre-filled into the Recertification for review and edits.
