Restored Homes HDFC is pleased to announce that applications are now being accepted for one and two family homes currently being rehabilitated at the following locations:

STATEN ISLAND

- 25 Bowen Street, Concord (CB 1), \$249,000 (one family)

QUEENS

- 108-05 160th Street, Jamaica (CB 12), \$300,000 (one family)

In partnership with the City of New York's Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD), Restored Homes HDFC is rehabilitating these properties purchased from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Preference will be given to New York City residents. Current residents of Staten Island Community Board 1 and Queens Community Boards 10, 12 and 13 will receive a preference for 50% of the homes; military personnel who served on active duty in "Operation Enduring Freedom" and "Operation Iraqi Freedom" at any time after September 11, 2001, or their surviving spouses, will receive a preference for 33 $\frac{1}{3}$ % of the homes; municipal employees of the City of New York will receive a 5% preference. *Applicants who currently own, or have in the last five years owned, a residence developed under an HPD program or project, are ineligible.*

- To qualify, applicants cannot have an annual income greater than \$99,840.
- There is an asset cap of \$150,000.
- Household size may be considered when matching a buyer with a home
