Applications postmarked after **September 20, 2010** will be set aside for possible future consideration. Applications will be selected on a first come, first served basis, monitored by HPD. Applicants who submit more than one application will be disqualified. Duplicated applications will not be accepted. Preference will be given to New York City residents. Current and eligible residents of **Brooklyn Community Board 16** will receive preference for 50% of the units. Eligible households that include persons with visual and/or hearing impairments will receive preference for 2% of the units; and eligible City of New York Municipal Employees will receive a 5% preference.
