## APPLICATION CHECKLIST FOR THRU-WALL HVAC UNITS ON SECONDARY AND NON-VISIBLE FAÇADES

LPC can FasTrack permits for through-the-wall HVAC equipment that isn’t visible from any public thoroughfare if its installation does not affect the building’s significant architectural features or decorative masonry and the grille is set flush with the masonry wall. Projections of up to 5 inches may be permitted if the equipment is 25 square inches or less in surface area and causes no adverse effects to the façade. **Please note your project will not be eligible for FasTrack Service if there are outstanding LPC violations against the property where the work is proposed.**

**For FasTrack service, you’ll need to submit:**

- A permit application form signed by the owner of the building
- Photo(s) of building indicating the proposed unit location(s)
- Site plan, building footprint plan, block plan, or Sanborn map showing the location of the work will not be visible from a public thoroughfare
- Elevation drawings showing unit's relationship to window(s) and dimensions of existing grille
- Section drawing showing grille as either flush with masonry or projecting up to five inches
- Paint card or indication of the color to be used to match the surrounding masonry
