His work has broad impact on 45 areas of human services, affecting over 7 million individuals throughout the United States and Canada.

Adam has lived in Lower Manhattan his entire life. His lifelong residence at Independence Plaza (IPN) connects him with every facet of the downtown community. His mother was a New York City public school teacher and his father worked for New York City's Probation Department. Adam's identity is the basis for his community activism.
