Resolution:

COMMUNITY BOARD TEN'S OPPOSITION TO THE NYC DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION'S PROPOSED LAYOFFS OF 4,400 NYC PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS

Whereas, the current resources provided to District 3 and 5 public schools within Community Board 10 would be significantly negatively affected by the proposed layoffs;

Whereas, given the high number of persistently low-performing public schools within Community Board 10, the effect of the proposed budget cuts and layoffs would further exacerbate educational failure for students in this community; and

Therefore be It Resolved, Community Board 10 strongly and emphatically opposes any and all budget cuts to the Department of Education which result in the loss of teachers specifically to schools in Community Board 10, and within the City of New York in general.

At a regularly scheduled General Board Meeting on Wednesday June 1, 2011, Manhattan Community Board 10 voted to approve this resolution with a vote of 38 Yes, 1 No, 0 Abstentions.
