**Resolution to Support Amending New York State Education Law  
Sections 2590-e and 2590-g with the proposed Subdivision 22.**

**WHEREAS** The Harlem community has experienced a large number of co-locations of charter schools within currently existing public schools;

**WHEREAS** Harlem parents do not have a sufficient mechanism to approve school co-locations, closures, truncations, and phase outs;

**WHEREAS** The proposed amendment to existing New York State Education Law directly addresses the need for community input in the decision-making process by allowing Community Education Councils to exert local representation;

**WHEREAS** The Education, Libraries, and Youth committee voted **6 in favor 0 opposed**.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** Manhattan Community Board 10 supports the proposed amendment to New York State Education Law Sections 2590-e and 2590-g with the proposed Subdivision 22.
