Resolution: Support of the Wine and Beer License Application of Harlem Burger Co. LLC, d/b/a "Harlem Burger Company," for a new establishment to be located at 2190 Frederick Douglass Blvd., New York, NY 10026.

**WHEREAS,** the New York State Liquor Authority (SLA) has jurisdiction to issue on-premises licenses according to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Laws, and is responsible for enforcing those laws; and

**WHEREAS,** Manhattan Community Board 10 reviews all new applications and offers guidance to the SLA about the potential impact of a license on public safety and quality of life in our District; and

**WHEREAS**, Community Boards, as part of their due diligence process, review an applicant's ownership and funding; floor plans of the proposed location, food and beverage to be served, operational aspects of the restaurant/bar or lounge, price points, employee hiring processes, employee wages and benefits, and community involvement; and

**WHEREAS,** Harlem Burger Co. LLC is applying for a Wine and Beer License for a new establishment to be known as "Harlem Burger Company" located at 2190 Frederick Douglass Blvd., New York, NY 10026 (NE corner of 118<sup>th</sup> Street); and

**WHEREAS**, the Applicant's principal Alper Uyanik appeared before Community Board 10's Economic Development Committee on February 10, 2016 and presented the following information:

- 1. Mr. Uyanik is the principal owner of Harlem Pizza Company, which has been operating with a Wine and Beer License for over a year on 116<sup>th</sup> Street between Adam Clayton Powell Jr. Blvd. and Frederick Douglass Blvd. Mr. Uyanik is a resident of Harlem who lives across the street from the proposed new establishment.
- **2.** Applicant has obtained a 5-year lease with a three 5-year options to renew for the premises.
- **3.** The restaurant's seating capacity will be 30 patrons. The restaurant will feature communal seating with no wait staff. The floor plan is 900 square feet.

- **4.** The restaurant will not have a bar, but will have a small wine and beer selection. The food menu will consist of sliders, fish and chicken priced at \$7.00 \$9:00.
- **5.** The establishment will be open Sunday to Thursday form 12:00 noon to 11:00 pm and on Friday and Saturday from 12:00 noon to 2:00 am. The establishment will provide delivery service.
- **6.** The restaurant will not provide any live music. It will provide recorded background music only.
- 7. The Applicant plans to employ 10 people. At the Applicant's existing restaurant (Harlem Pizza Company), 90% of the employees live in Harlem, and the Applicant plans to replicate this hiring model at the proposed establishment.
- **8.** The Applicant will pay starting employees \$10.00 to \$13.00 per hour.
- **9.** The establishment's entry, interior and restrooms will be disabled and wheelchair accessible; and

**WHEREAS**, the Applicant has provided a petition of support signed by 24 neighboring residents, and

**WHEREAS**, the Economic Development Committee voted 9-yes, 0-no, and 0-abstention to support this application;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that on March 2, 2016, the Manhattan Borough Community Board 10 supports the Wine and Beer License application of Harlem Burger Co. LLC with a vote of 23 in favor, 8 opposed and 0 abstentions.
