5. Committee Member Horry will work with committee members to create a resolution of support for the preservation of the Harlem Hospital Women's Pavilion and possible incorporation into the construction of the planned public health laboratory building.
6. Committee Member Horry will work with committee members to develop a resolution in support of maintaining the current names of historic Harlem neighborhoods.
