

Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes – CB 12 Manhattan

Meeting called to order at 7:05pm by Assistant Chair Owen-Michaane

- Chairman Ally welcomed everyone
- **NYPD 33rd Precinct report – Sgt. Rodriguez**
 - Elaborated on the “Community Policing/Reengineering” Program as announced by 1PP and City Hall
 - As part of community policing, more officers will be assigned to specific areas, and those officers will remain constant
 - Officers to be pulled from various duties to fill the community policing program
 - The 33rd has requested an increase in officers and vehicles as they plan to launch the test pilot of community policing
 - Several new officers have been assigned to the Anti-Crime Unit and Conditions Unit
 - Burglaries in the 33rd are down
 - Jim Berlin discussed his view of the history of community policing and the impact on communities
 - Uptick in grand larcenies
 - A request was made to have the 33rd Precinct make a presentation to the Aging Committee
 - A request was made to have a consistent rep from the 33rd report to the monthly PS Committee meetings, who can provide follow up from prior committee meetings
- **NYPD 34th Precinct report – Officer Perez**
 - Real Estate scam artist Jennifer Ricardo arrested on Feb. 23rd
 - Arrest made in 186th/Audubon Shooting
 - The 34th is up in all crime stats, including grand larcenies
 - The announcements on the Forum will be sent out by the CB office on Monday the 10th of Nov.
- **New Business**
 - For April Meeting the CCRB will be making a presentation
 - For the May meeting, DV Presentation from the Mayor’s Office, and there was a request to have community group input
