### **I. 34<sup>th</sup> Pct. Report – presented by P.O. Perez**

- The 34<sup>th</sup> precinct reports that, for the 28-day reporting period, up on every category. 3<sup>rd</sup> homicide in November. November 12, stabbing on 207<sup>th</sup>. The increase of robberies is attributable to the string of robberies in the park.
- A pattern of commercial burglaries in the vicinity of 182<sup>nd</sup> and St. Nicholas Avenue.
- Precinct issued a reminder to residents to restrict access to residential building to only individuals who reside in the building or invited guest.

### **II. 33<sup>rd</sup> Pct. Report- presentation by Captain Natalie and P.O. Gomez**

- Crime is generally up for the 28-day reporting period, 37%. The increase is attributable to burglaries. Flyers distributed regarding Quality of Life concerns.
