Whereas, Fat Pig Inc. located at 120 Dyckman Street, (corner of Post Ave.), has duly notified Community Board 12 Manhattan of its intention to file an application for On-Premises Liquor License; and

Whereas, the Licensing Committee met on December 14th, 2016 to hear comments from the community and the precinct regarding the establishment. And was informed that the 34th Precinct request a meeting with the owner; and

Whereas, Congressman Elect Espaillat rep Laurie Tobias Cohen stated that this is a residential block that is already extremely congested with liquor licenses. Granting the license will mean forgoing the 500 ft. Rule. The back of the establishment faces a residential block and the SLA asked that the applicant find a different location due to the saturation of liquor licenses and proximity to a residential area. The Committee has a responsibility to consider the welfare of the families living near by that cannot be at the meeting today, not just the businesses that we are trying to promote; and

Whereas, Community resident Jennifer B. indicated that there are too many liquor licenses on the block already; and
