- Whereas, the last Department of Health inspection resulted in 80 violations; a previous inspection resulted in 40 violations including very unsanitary conditions, hand washing, and wrong dishwashing soap. Additionally, there is a newly opened rehabilitation center very close to the establishment; and
- Whereas, applicant stated that she is not aware of any issues in her establishment; and

H. Inwood Rezoning

After the Committee's business agenda was completed a discussion ensued about the Inwood Rezoning plan. Committee members and residents offered comments:

- Our community is becoming an increasingly vibrant place to live
- Large corporations are expanding but small businesses cannot compete due to higher rent
- There are not enough parking spots; municipal and affordable parking garages are needed
- For every city owned lot there should be a percentage of that space allocated for small businesses
- Preservation and protection of small businesses is crucial to the community
- Tax incentives for lease renewals could help keep the existing businesses in our neighborhood
- The displacement of locally-owned small businesses is imminent without any programs to protect them

After further discussion the committee felt that no C6 zoning should be permitted in the district and that in order to keep local, family owned establishments the City should implement programs that incentivize landlords to renew leases for small businesses in spaces that fall under C5 zoning. Alternatively, enforce higher percentages of tax on spaces that are larger than C5 zoning. The size of new bars, lounges and large restaurants should be in relation to the size of the building. The 500 and 200 ft. rules should be enforced and should trigger an automatic 'no new liquor license' provision due to saturation.
