- **The meeting was called to order** at about 7:12pm by the Chair.
- **Report from Public Safety Agencies (May 6th - June 2nd)**
  - 33rd (Lt. Adam Concepcion)
    - No homicides, 4 vs. 1YA rape (Domestic mostly), robberies down by one (-12%), 6 vs. 1YA Burglaries (highest increase; many could be preventable), 12 vs. 10 YA Grand Larcenies (Credit Card & Identity thefts, ~75%), 3 vs. 3 YA (vehicle thefts),
    - Up 13 crimes (~+38%)
    - Shootings for the year: past four months, no shootings
  - 34th (Lt. Craig Nilsen)
    - Down 10% in total crimes
    - Homicides, 3 vs. 4 (-24%), 18 vs. 10 (robberies), 10 vs. 9 (burglaries), 50 vs. 45 (Larcenies), 6 vs. 2 (Grand Larcenies), 5 vs. 1 (Bicyclists Struck)
    - Crime increase is 20% vs. YA (last year was very low)
    - Two shootings (Random)
      - Post Avenue (3 in custody; still looking for three; robbery)
      - 54 Nagel (2 outstanding suspects)
    - Increase of package thefts
    - Member Danielle mentioned the Resolution on Response Times, spurred by the hit-and-run bicycle incident she witnessed
- **Discussion on Summer and Strategic Planning/Preparations around the Community**
  - Discussed the increase in cops to address the increase in people attending baseball games in our parks and other gathering areas
  - Explained the 34th Precincts approach to monitoring the clubs and bars in the area. Increase in cop coverage and new patrol protocol.
  - Will there be a consistent nightlife meeting with the night-business owners? [Need Follow-up]
  - Confirmation that the 34th Pct. monitors La Marina while it's abandoned, but there has been vandalism and robbery

- June 26th Highbridge Park Pool opens - three officers assigned from 33rd Pct., 7 day coverage from 11am - 7pm
- What is the plan with preventing fireworks?
  - 34th - There's a fireworks plan from NYPD leadership that hasn't come down to the precincts yet
- **Building More Bridges Recess**
  - Ely reported on the Building Bridges event, on how it was a great success and very successful
- **Old Business/New Business:**
  - Resolution: Bicycle/Motor Vehicle Accidents & Response Time
    - Committee Votes: 6-0-0-0, Unanimous
    - Public: 2-0-0-0, Unanimous (3 abstain)
  - Ely Update from DA's Office
    - Indictment of Two Males that were representing themselves as Immigration Attorneys
      - Call-to-Action, if you see Immigration scams: 212 335 3600
      - David Moreno (41 years)); Victor Espinal (69 years)
  - Build the Block NCO Meetings
    - June 20th Sector Charlie - Incarnation School
    - June 26th Sector Boyd - Boricua College
  - New Recruits
    - 33rd getting 6
    - 34th getting 5
