At the General Meeting on Tuesday, January 23, 2018, with a vote of 31 in favor, 5 opposed, 2 abstentions, 0 not voting, Community Board 12 Manhattan, passed a resolution of **No Objection** to the New York State Liquor Authority New application for an On-Premises Liquor License for Café Bark Inc. dba Café Bark; and

Whereas, Café Bark Inc. dba Café Bark 833 W 181 St (btw Cabrini Blvd & Pinehurst Ave) 10033, has duly notified Community Board 12 Manhattan of its intention to file an application for a New On-Premises Liquor License; and

Whereas, the Licensing Committee met on January 10th, 2018 to hear comments from the community and the precinct regarding this establishment's request for a New license; and

Whereas, the restaurant is on the street level of a six (6) story Mixed Residential and Commercial building with 79 residential units; and

Whereas, the proposed venue will operates with a total of 5 tables, 15 chairs, and 10 bar stools, with a total maximum legal capacity of 75 persons. Hours of operation 8AM to 1AM seven (7) days a week; and

Whereas, The proposed establishment is within 500 ft. of five (5) other On- Premises Liquor license businesses; and

Whereas, the proposed establishment's proposed Method of Operation includes Juke Box, iPod, Internet and recoded Music only; and

Whereas, Serving area and kitchen will be isolated from the pet area by a double door, and the establishment will be air- conditioned. There will also be a separate venting system to move air out of the animal area; and

Whereas, As per the landlord's request a drop ceiling and foam insulation will be applied to mitigate sound emitting from the establishment; and

Whereas, members of the community have no objection to the opening of this establishment but the 34th Precinct request to meet with the owners; and

Whereas, the applicant agreed in writing to implement the stipulations stated below:

- The owners will meet with the 34th precinct prior to the Community Board 12 Manhattan General Meeting in January 23rd, 2018
- Post a publicly displayed Good Neighbor sign
- Post a publicly displayed sign that patrons must clean up after their pets; therefore, be it

Resolved, that Community Board 12 Manhattan **Does Not Object** to the New York State Liquor Authority New On-Premises Liquor License for Café Bark with the stipulations stated above.
