Re: Resolution to Extend the Public Comment Period to the draft Scope of Work for the NYCEDC EAS/EIS for the Inwood NYC Rezoning Project.

Hon. Esther Brunner:

At the General Meeting, Tuesday, September, 26, 2017 Community Board 12 Manhattan, passed the following resolution with a vote of [38] in favor, [0] opposed, [1] abstention requesting that the Scope of Work be extended to October 31st, 2017 so that Community Board, 12 Manhattan and its respective committees have sufficient time to secure public comment to the proposed Scope of Work and respond, pursuant to the City Charter, as a full Board, with a single resolution.

Whereas: the New York City Economic Development Corporation (NYCEDC) issued a Scope of Work Proposal regarding the Inwood Rezoning Project on August 11, 2017; and

Whereas: the issuance of this proposal occurred during the summer hiatus when, pursuant to the New York City Charter, Community Boards do not meet; and

Whereas: the requirement for response to the proposal specifies a deadline of September 25, 2017, 45 days from the date of issuance; and

Whereas: the proposal is of a sufficient magnitude as to impact every area of purview of each of the Board's ten Committees, and requires a thorough review by the Board; and;

Whereas: the time limit for review and response precedes the first General Meeting (September 26, 2017) of Community Board 12 after the summer recess; and

Whereas: each Committee of Community Board 12 will need to meet, accept public comments and submit a report on the Scope of Work to the entire Board prior to a full Board review; and

Whereas: the time to complete this work exceeds the 45-day deadline provided; now therefore

Be it Resolved that the deadline to submit comments on the Scope of Work be extended to October 31, 2017 so that Community Board, 12 Manhattan and its respective committees have sufficient time to secure public comment to the proposed Scope of Work and respond, pursuant to the City Charter, as a full Board, with a single resolution.
