RE: Key Terms Clarification Zoning Text Amendment

Dear Commissioner Burden,

Please be advised that at the General Board Meeting of Community Board 12- Manhattan, held on Tuesday, December 21, 2010, the following resolution in support of the "Key Terms Clarification Zoning Text Amendment" proposed by the New York City Department of City Planning was passed by a majority vote of 38 In Favor, 0 Opposed and 1 Abstaining.

Whereas:

The terms "development" and "building" are used throughout the 1961 New York City Zoning Resolution (the "ZR") but are not used or defined consistently. These two terms are central to the ZR. Therefore, the New York City Department of City Planning ("DCP") has examined each section of the ZR which uses the terms "development" or "building" and has concluded that in order to clarify the meaning of the zoning regulations consistent with their intent, it is necessary to amend the definition of these two terms and to modify other zoning text to clarify the intent of the ZR, resolve conflicting regulations or to bring a regulation in to accordance with current Department of Buildings practice. To implement these zoning text clarifications and modifications DCP has drafted and referred for review the Key Terms Clarification Zoning Text Amendment (the "Key Terms Amendment"); and

Whereas:

When the ZR was adopted the term "development" was intended to refer to a new building constructed under the then-new zoning regulations. However, the continued applicability of the zoning regulations to buildings after they are constructed, i.e.: buildings that are existing thus no longer new, has been questioned. Also, amendments to the ZR have used the term "development" inconsistently - in some instances intended to mean only new construction on a zoning lot and in other instances new construction as well as existing buildings on a zoning lot; and

Whereas:

The ZR defines the term "building" as being bounded by open area or by lot lines. This definition has created a situation where if there a multiple abutting buildings on a single zoning lot they are considered, for zoning purposes, a single building. This definition of "building" has caused confusion and resulted in litigation. Also, when two or more abutting buildings on a

single zoning lot are defined as a single building, various zoning regulations such as location of uses, the sliver rule, the dormer rule, R7-2 / R8 tower rule and rules for rear yards in mixed-use buildings do not work as intended; and

Whereas:

It is beneficial to Washington Heights and Inwood for the definition and intent of terms defined and used in the ZR to be clear and consistent so that property owners know what can be built on their property, the general public know what can be built in their neighborhoods, the Department of Buildings has clearer standards for zoning compliance and architects, developers and builders have regulations that remove ambiguities; and

Whereas:

On June 30, 2010 DCP hosted an informational meeting to provide an overview of the Key Terms Amendment, on September 27, 2010 DCP referred the Amendment to community boards, Borough Presidents and the Borough Board for review and on December 1, 2010 DCP presented the Amendment to the Land Use Committee of Community Board 12-Manahttan; Now, therefore, be it

Resolved:

Community Board 12-Manhattan supports the "Key Terms Clarification Zoning Text Amendment" proposed by the NYC Department of City Planning.
