

75 Morton Street Fact Sheet



- Easily accessible from M20 bus and **A** **C** **E**, **B** **D** **F** **M**, **1** and **L** trains
- 177,000 square ft. and 7 stories
 - Handicap accessible
 - Includes gymnasium/auditorium, cafeteria and parking lot on Barrow Street
 - 68 feet above water line
- Opportunity to house public middle school(s) for District 2
- Speaker Quinn allocated \$2mm in FY 2014

75 Morton: Imagine a School

- Goal: Open Fall 2015 for current 3rd grade students
- Potential for one large school or multiple smaller schools

School Type	Seats
Elementary and Middle School (K-8)	600 - 700
Middle School (6-8)	700 - 900
3 Middle Schools (6-8)	3 x 300
Middle School and High School (6-12)	600 - 1,000
Pre-K and K Plus MS and HS (6-12)	100 + 700
Many Other Possibilities	900

- Regardless of programming, 75 Morton needs a full gymnasium, other movement rooms, auditorium, cafeteria and full complement of art, music and science rooms
