At its Full Board meeting on November 29, 2012, Community Board #2, Manhattan (CB#2, Man.) adopted the following resolution:

Street Activity Applications:

1. 12/1/12 La Veronica Church, Christopher St. bet. Greenwich St. & Washington St., SAPO# 73383

Whereas, the area was posted, community groups notified and there were no community members present regarding this application, and the applicant's representative, James LaMorte, was present, and

Whereas, this is a new application for a street fair at this location, but it is a single-block fair which will support continuing roof repairs on St. Veronica Church, which is on this block,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that CB#2, Man. supports this street fair permit application on the date and at the location listed above.

Vote: Unanimous, with 45 Board members in favor.

2. 12/12/12 La Guadalupe Virgin Celebration, West 14th St. bet. 8th & 9th Ave., SAPO# 73381

Whereas, the area was posted, community groups notified and there were no community members present regarding this application, and the applicant's representative, James LaMorte, was present, and

Whereas, this is a new application for a street fair at this location, but it is a single-block fair which is intended to support continuing roof repairs on Our Lady of Guadalupe Church, which is on this block, and

Whereas, the application contained several errors, including the date (the 12th is a Wednesday), the location (SAPO is not approving new fairs on 14th Street due to the level of traffic disruption), and the Sponsor was listed as a private company, not the church, and


Whereas, while the applicant was able to update the application for the date (Sunday, Dec. 9) and change the Sponsor to the church, the applicant proposed moving the fair to Washington St. between 13th St. and 14th St., which given the distance from the church and extremely busy nature of this area near the High Line on Sundays, the committee was not willing to support, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that CB#2, Man. **DOES NOT** support this street fair permit application on the date and at either of the locations proposed above

Vote: Unanimous, with 45 Board members in favor.
