Monday, February 17 – Friday, February 21, 2014:

Operation #1 Location #1	complete backfilling of pipe and remaining activities Cooper Square west, between 6 th and 7 th Streets
Operation #2 Location #2	Excavation and Installation of new sewer manholes Astor Place and Lafayette
Operation #3 Location #3	Excavation and Installation of new sewer manholes Astor Place and 4 th Avenue
Operation #4 Location #4	Excavations to relocate ECS duct banks S/E/C of Third Avenue & E. 6 th Street
Operation #5 Location #5	Weekly rodent control operations continue Peter Cooper Triangle

**Rodent Control Operations continue, within project limits, in and around the Peter Cooper Village, expanding to Village Triangle and throughout Cooper Square.

Community Impacts:

- Pedestrian access will be protected and maintained at all times.
- Vehicular access/partial lane closures may need to be temporarily restricted in order to facilitate construction. (Flag person will aid in facilitating vehicles)
- Dust, noise and heavy equipment are common elements of construction and we ask for your patience during the project.
- To facilitate construction, some parking spaces may need to be temporarily eliminated
- Driveway/loading dock access may be temporarily interrupted to facilitate construction
- Certain operations will be noisy; DDC will monitor operations to assure that they are within DEP Noise Code Regulations.

Please Note:

- If an operation was not started/completed in the previous week, it will remain on the schedule until completed.
- Test Pits and roadway maintenance will require the use of heavy machinery and jackhammering.
- All equipment used on DDC projects are as per DEP Codes and Standards.

Due to unforeseen conditions (weather, field conditions, etc.) it may become necessary to change some scheduled work locations and operations.
