

The activity is open to all ages. Children under 13 years old must be accompanied by an adult. Participation is free, first come, first served.

Summer Streets is a celebration of New York City's most valuable public space - our streets. On three consecutive Saturdays in the summer, nearly seven miles of NYC's streets are opened for people to play, walk, bike and breathe. Summer Streets provides more space for healthy recreation and encourages New Yorkers to use more sustainable forms of transportation.
