Through a safe, easy, effective method, Bike New York's experienced instructors help parents teach their kids how to balance, pedal, start, stop, and steer a bicycle. Most kids get it in one session, but even if they don't, parents leave knowing an easy, crash-free, low stress technique that will have their kids riding independently in a short amount of time.
