- ◆ **Have your valuable portable equipment serial numbers recorded by the NYPD:** bring your cell phones, tablets and laptops for tracking so they can be returned if stolen/recovered
- ◆ **Protect yourself, your identity and your property** with information from the NYPD

- ◆ **Suggested items include:** bills, credit card charge receipts, credit applications, insurance forms, bank statements, expired charge cards, pre-approved credit offers, old (7+ years) tax returns and anything with your social security or personal information on it.
- ◆ **No limit** – bring as much or as little as you wish.
- ◆ **The destroyed paper will be recycled.**
