RECONSTRUCTION OF ASTOR PLACE/COOPER SQUARE PROJECT #HWMP116

WATER MAIN INSTALLATION

(NO PARKING PERMITTED/TRAFFIC LANE REDUCTION)

ON COOPER SQUARE WEST: From East 6th Street to Astor Place

On Wednesday, February 12th, contractor will begin installing the new 12" water main pipe on Cooper Square West, from E. 6th Street to Astor Place. In order for the existing water main to be replaced, the water must be shut off, old pipe removed and new pipe installed. Prior to this water main installation, NYCDEP conducted a water main test shut down to check and test that all the valves that turn the water on and off were working properly. During the test shut down it was observed that stakeholders were **NOT** affected or went without water. Therefore, we anticipate that no one will be affected during this shutdown. Your water should remain available throughout installation unless otherwise advised.

Community Impacts:

The following are temporary impacts while the work is being performed:

- Traffic Lane Reduction: One-lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction. Upon completion of the work day, normal traffic pattern will be restored.
- **"No Parking"**: West curb lane, from E. 6th Street to Astor Place
- Pedestrian crosswalk on E. 6th & Cooper Square West: Closed during water main work.
- Flaggers will be in place on both sides of operation.
- While the contractor will employ all available noise mitigation techniques, this work will entail elevated levels of noise: DDC will monitor operations to assure that they are within the DEP Noise Code regulations.
