LOCATION(S) AFFECTED:

- Gansevoort Street/ Gansevoort Plaza Area between Hudson Street and Washington Street
- Greenwich Street from Gansevoort Street to Jane Street
- Horatio Street from Greenwich Street to Hudson Street
- 9th Avenue from West 13th Street to Gansevoort Street

WHY IS MY WATER BEING TURNED OFF?

On Wednesday, May 18, 2016, NYC DDC will begin the 12" water main replacement operation on Gansevoort Street/Plaza area. In order to facilitate this operation, a water shutoff is needed in the aforementioned locations. Buildings within those limits should be the only properties affected. You will receive a 24hr notice confirming or cancelling this water service interruption or changes to affected locations, date and/or time, if applicable.

If you are uncertain where your water service connection enters your building and/or establishment, please inquire with your Landlord (Super, Property Manager, Plumber etc.). All construction activities are weather and field conditions permitting.

SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- DDC recommends that a qualified person shut off the water main "house" valve in your house/building in order to avoid sediment entering your building's system, which is common with this type of operation.
- You are asked to shut off all WATER-COOLED appliances, which may include air conditioners, etc.
- Once water service is restored, turn the main house valve back on and flush the system by running your faucets to sinks and tubs for a few minutes.
