WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT OPERATION

LOCATION(S) AFFECTED:

- West 13th Street from Hudson Street to 10th Avenue
- 9th Avenue from West 14th Street to West Gansevoort Street
- Gansevoort Street from Hudson Street to Washington Street

WHY IS MY WATER BEING TURNED OFF?

ON/ABOUT Monday, March 7, 2016, NYC DDC will begin excavation for the 12" water main replacement operation on West 13th Street from Hudson Street to 10th Avenue; 9th Avenue from West 14th Street to Gansevoort Street and Gansevoort Street from Hudson Street to Washington Street. In order to facilitate this operation, a water shutoff is required within the afore-mentioned limits. The contractors will be prepping the trench and water main for the actual shutdown. Buildings within those limits should be the only properties affected. You will receive a 72HR and a 24hr notice confirming or cancelling this water service interruption or changes to affected locations once scheduled.

****A test water shutdown has been scheduled for Wednesday, March 9, 2016 between 2AM and 5AM.** These test shutdowns are to ensure the water valves are in working condition. If for any reason the valves are not operational, the shutdown limits will have to be re-evaluated and another test shutdown scheduled. You will also receive a 72HR and 24HR notice confirming or cancelling this interruption. ******

If you are uncertain where your water service connection enters your building and/or establishment, please inquire with your Landlord (Super, Property Manager, Plumber etc.). All construction activities are weather and field conditions permitting. You will receive updated information as the operation start date approaches and more information becomes available.

SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:


- DDC recommends that a qualified person shut off the water main "house" valve in your house/building in order to avoid sediment entering your building's system, which is common with this type of operation.
- You are asked to shut off all WATER-COOLED appliances, which may include air conditioners, etc.
- Once water service is restored, turn the main house valve back on and flush the system by running your faucets to sinks and tubs for a few minutes.
