LOCATION:

- GANSEVOORT STREET BETWEEN HUDSON STREET AND 9TH AVENUE
- GANSEVOORT STREET PLAZA

NYC DDC Construction Project HWMP2020, is scheduled to begin field operations in the Gansevoort Street/Gansevoort Plaza area between Hudson Street and 9th Avenue. Field work will continue on 9th Avenue between West 16th Street and Gansevoort Street.

WORK TO BE COMPLETED:

- Con Edison facilities upgrade
- ECS facilities upgrade
- Distribution water main replacement (requires water service interruption(s))
- Drainage work
- Landscaping
- Final restoration

WHAT ARE THE COMMUNITY IMPACTS?

The DDC is committed to maintaining a work site that is safe and clean. However, dust, noise and heavy equipment are common elements of construction and we ask for your patience during the project. Permitted work hours are 7AM to 6PM.

- Due to the construction, there will be no public seating available in this area until further notice.

Water Service Interruption

In order to replace sections of the existing 12" distribution water main, water service interruptions will be required. You will receive a minimum of 72HR notice before a water service interruption takes place. Please check with your Building/Property Manager, Super and/or Plumber to inquire where the water feed enters your building.

- You will receive updates via our Weekly Look-Ahead and Advisories regarding water service interruptions once they are scheduled.

Private Carting/Sanitation Pick-up

- Trash should be placed at the nearest available spot for pickup which is readily accessible to Sanitation or your private carting company. Please inform you private carting about these changes.

Pedestrian / Traffic


- Pedestrian access to buildings will be maintained at all times.

- Deliveries will be coordinated as feasible
