NEW ROADWAY/CURB & SIDEWALK INSTALLATIONS

LOCATION:

➤ 4th AVENUE: FROM E. 8th to E. 9th STREETS

FULL ROADWAY CLOSURE/NO PARKING/NO STANDING -24/7

Beginning on/about Wednesday, May 11th, and continuing for approximately three (3) weeks

Beginning on/about Wednesday, May 11th, **weather and field conditions permitting**, the New York City Department of Design + Construction (NYCDDC) will begin the roadway excavations/installations along 4th Avenue. New curb/sidewalk work will follow. Once completed, the contractor will continue curb/sidewalk work along E. 8th, from 3rd to 4th Avenues. Vehicular traffic will be affected.

When concrete is poured for new curbs/sidewalks, it must cure for one day before use. During that time, pedestrians will be required to detour around it. Certain pedestrian crosswalks will be closed and/or limited sidewalk access. Please observe and follow detour signs.

WORK TO BE COMPLETED (BUT NOT LIMITED TO):

- Installing new concrete roadway
- New granite curbs and extended concrete sidewalks, with special scoring and exposed aggregate, tinted.

TRAFFIC/COMMUNITY IMPACTS:

- **FULL ROADWAY CLOSURE 24/7:** 4th Avenue, from E. 8th to E. 9th St. Please follow detour.
- **"No Parking/No Standing"** restrictions will be in effect 24/7. Please observe/adhere to all posted signage.
- Access to entryways and businesses will be maintained at all times.
- Emergency access will be maintained at all times.
- Deliveries will be coordinated when/where feasible.
- Garbage Collection locations will be "Temporarily" relocated.
- Flaggers/NYPD Traffic Agents: Will be stationed during work hours to mitigate traffic/address safety issues.
- Certain operations will be noisy; the contractor will employ all available noise mitigation techniques, **this work will entail elevated levels of noise.** DDC will monitor operations to assure that they are within the DEP Noise Code Regulations.
