Weekend Work: Saturday, March 01, 2014

Operation: Con-Edison cable installation
Location: 3rd Avenue between 7th & Astor Place

Monday, March 3 – Friday, March 7, 2014:

Operation #1 Continue with excavations and Installation of sewer main and manhole
Location #1 Crossing along E. 8th Street, between 4th Avenue and Lafayette Street
(This activity will entail elevated noise levels)

Operation #2 Excavation and installation of sewer main and manhole
Location #2 Astor Place from Lafayette to 4th Avenue (Cooper Square West)
(This activity will entail elevated noise levels)

Operation #3 Installation of new sewer main and manhole
Location #3 4th Avenue between E. 8th & E. 9th streets

Operation #4 Full Street Closure 24/7
Location #4 Astor Place from Lafayette to 4th Avenue (Cooper Square West)

Operation #5 Continue excavation and relocation of ECS duct banks
Location #5 South east corner of Third Avenue & E. 6th Street

Operation #6 Intermittent Street closures during certain operations
Location #6 E. 8th Street between Lafayette and 4th Avenue

Operation #7 Weekly rodent control operations continue
Location #7 Peter Cooper Triangle

Community Impacts:

- Pedestrian access will be protected and maintained at all times.
- Emergency Vehicle access will be maintained at all times
- During certain operations, vehicular access/partial street & lane closures may need to be temporarily restricted in order to facilitate construction. (Flag person will aid in facilitating vehicles)
- Dust, noise and heavy equipment are common elements of construction and we ask for your patience during the project.
- Contractor will employ all available noise mitigation techniques, certain operations will entail elevated levels of noise; DDC will monitor operations to assure that they are within DEP Noise Code Regulations.

Please Note:

- Please Follow all Posted Pedestrian Detour & Construction Signage!
- Pedestrians are urged to exercise extreme caution when in the construction area and use an alternate route when possible.
- If an operation was not started/completed in the previous week, it will remain on the schedule until completed.
- All equipment used on DDC projects are as per DEP Codes and Standards.

Due to unforeseen conditions (weather, field conditions, etc.) it may become necessary to change some scheduled work locations and operations.
