02-29-16 to 03-04-16	Intersection of Astor Place & Cooper Sq.	Stripping of forms of Con-Ed Oil-O-Static cradle/backfilling/temporarily restoring trench (Elevated Noise Levels)	7:00AM to 6:00PM (Day Work)
02-29-16 to 03-04-16	Village Plaza	Continue installation of granite stepped seating	7:00AM to 6:00PM (Day Work)
02-29-16 to 03-04-16	Cooper Sq. West between E. 6 th & E. 7 th Streets	sawcutting joints & sealing expansion joints (Elevated Noise Levels)	7:00AM to 6:00PM (Day Work)
02-29-16 to 03-04-16	Cooper Sq. between E. 7 th & Astor Place	Excavation of existing roadway, grading and placing 12" concrete roadway (Elevated Noise Levels)	7:00AM to 6:00PM (Day Work)
