WATER MAIN SHUT DOWN

**MONDAY, JANUARY 5 AND TUESDAY, JANUARY 06, 2015
FROM 8:00 AM UNTIL 4:00 PM (BOTH DAYS)
AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATION:
COOPER SQ. WEST, FROM E. 6TH ST. TO ASTOR PLACE**

The New York City Department of Design + Construction (NYCDDC) will begin the installation of the new 12" distribution water main on Cooper Square West, from E. 6th to Astor Place. While this work is being performed, the E. 6th street northbound traffic lane will be temporarily closed to traffic. Access for emergency vehicles, as well as access to parking garage will be given. At the end of the work day, the roadway will be re-opened and normal traffic flow restored. Flaggers will be stationed during work hours to mitigate traffic and address safety issues.

Previous coordination and contact has been made with All Buildings affected by this shutdown.

If your location is not included within the above limits, you **SHOULD NOT BE AFFECTED** by the water shutdown. Should your building experience a change in water service, please contact the Community Construction Liaison.

****Please note:** A 24-hour advance notification will be distributed to any and/or all affected areas to confirm or cancel any scheduled water shut-off.

SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- The DDC recommends that a qualified person shut off the water main valve in your house/building in order to avoid sediment entering your building's system, which is common with this type of operation.
- You are asked to shut off all Water Cooled appliances, which may include air conditioners, large refrigeration devices, etc.
- Once water service is returned, turn the main house valve back on and flush the system by running your faucets, sinks and tubs, for a few minutes. Run only COLD Water until it appears clear.
- While the contractor will employ all available noise mitigation techniques, this work will entail elevated levels of noise. DDC will monitor operations to assure that they are within the DEP Noise Code Regulations.
