# WATER MAIN SHUT DOWN – “CONTINUATION”

**MONDAY, MARCH 23, 2015  
FROM 8:00 AM UNTIL 4:00 PM  
AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATION:  
4th AVENUE, BETWEEN E. 8th AND E. 9th STREETS**

The contractor will continue with the water main relocation, next Monday, March 23, 2015.

In order to install a new catch basin, on the S/W corner of 4th Avenue and E. 9th Street, the contractor will need to relocate the existing water main pipe that is directly in the way of the catch basin installation.

Previous coordination/contact has been made with All Buildings affected by this shutdown. If your location is not included within the above limits, you SHOULD NOT BE AFFECTED by the water shutdown. Should your building experience a change in water service, please contact the Community Construction Liaison.

#### TRAFFIC/COMMUNITY IMPACTS:

- N/B Traffic Lane: Possible intermittent lane closure or slow moving during work operations.
- Flaggers will be stationed during work hours to mitigate traffic and address safety issues.
- Emergency Vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

#### SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- The DDC recommends that a qualified person shut-off the water main valve in your house/building in order to avoid sediment entering your building's system, which is common with this type of operation.
- You are asked to shut-off all Water Cooled Appliances, which may include air conditioners, large refrigeration devices, etc.
- Once water service is returned, turn the main house valve back on and flush the system by running your faucets, sinks and tubs, for a few minutes. Run only COLD water until it appears clear.
- While the contractor will employ all available noise mitigation techniques, this work will entail elevated levels of noise. DDC will monitor operations to assure that they are within the DEP Noise Code Regulations.
