WORK OPERATIONS COMMENCE

West 10th Street between 5th Ave. to 6th Ave.

Restrictions to Curbside Parking Excavations/Installation of New Distribution Water Mains Installation of Tree Guards

Beginning On/About Thursday, June 11th, 2015
Monday through Friday 7:00am to 3:30pm

Beginning on/about the week of June 8, 2015 the City of New York Department of Design + Construction (DDC) will perform daily work operations to install and replace new distribution water mains on West 10th Street, between 5th and 6th Avenues in Manhattan.

Roadway excavations will begin on West 10th & 6th Avenue and continue east bound, toward 5th Avenue. Curbside parking will be "Temporarily" eliminated while work is being performed. Please observe all posted signage. Vehicles will be ticketed and/or towed.

TRAFFIC/COMMUNITY IMPACTS:

- **"NO PARKING" 24/7** restrictions will be in effect.
- East Bound Traffic Lanes: One traffic lane will remain open to traffic during work hours. At the end of the work day all traffic lanes will be open. Possible intermittent lane closures, or slow moving, may be required.
- Flaggers will be stationed during work hours to mitigate traffic and address safety issues.
- Access to entryways and businesses will be maintained at all times.
- While the contractor will employ all available noise mitigation techniques, this work will entail elevated levels of noise. DDC will monitor operations to assure that they are within the DEP Noise Code Regulations.
