INSTALLATION OF WATER MAINS ON WEST 10TH STREET PROJECT # MED-617

Borough: **MANHATTAN**

September 25th, 2015

WATER MAIN SHUT DOWN

Monday, September 28, 2015

FROM 8:30 AM UNTIL 4:30 PM

AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATION:

East 10th Street, 5th Avenue to University Place

The NYC Department of Design and Construction is managing the capital construction project on West 10th Street between West Street to 5th Avenue. A water shutdown is necessary, in order to replace the distribution water main. The shutdown is anticipated to begin at 8:30am and last for approximately eight (8) hours. On occasion, this work may be completed earlier and water service restored.

Previous coordination/contact has been made with All Buildings affected by this shutdown. If your location is not included within the above limits, you **SHOULD NOT BE AFFECTED** by the water shutdown. Should your building experience a change in water service, please contact the Community Construction Liaison.

TRAFFIC/COMMUNITY IMPACTS:

- E/B Traffic Lane: Possible intermittent lane closure or slow moving during work operations.
- Flaggers will be stationed during work hours to mitigate traffic and address safety issues.
- Emergency Vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- The DDC recommends that a qualified person shut-off the water main valve in your house/building in order to avoid sediment entering your building's system, which is common with this type of operation.
- You are asked to shut-off all Water Cooled Appliances, which may include air conditioners, large refrigeration devices, etc.
- Once water service is returned, turn the main house valve back on and flush the system by running your faucets, sinks and tubs, for a few minutes. Run only COLD water until it appears clear.
- While the contractor will employ all available noise mitigation techniques, this work will entail elevated levels of noise. DDC will monitor operations to assure that they are within the DEP Noise Code Regulations.
