Please be advised that on Tuesday October 11th (**weather and/or field conditions permitting**) from 8:00AM-4:00PM, there will be a water shutdown on West 4th St. between Mercer St. and Broadway. To facilitate the water work of MED608, a water shutdown is necessary and will occur on Tuesday October 11th

Traffic Impacts/Community Impacts:

- Water shutdown will occur from 8:00AM-4:00PM
- Construction may be cancelled due to weather or special work conditions, contact the CCL for inquiries regarding changes in schedule

Some things to remember:

- The DDC recommends that you shut off the water main valve in your house/building in order to avoid problems that may occur if/when sediment enters or is released from your plumbing
- You are asked to shut off all water cooler appliances, which may include air conditioners, etc.
- Once water service is returned, turn the main house valve back on and flush the system by running your faucets to sinks and tubs for a few minutes
