# TEST PIT ACTIVITIES

## \* North West Corner of Cooper Square West and E. 4<sup>th</sup> Street

Beginning on/or about Wednesday, August 6, 2014, the New York City Department of Design + Construction (DDC) will be excavating test pits on the North West corner of Cooper Square and E. 4<sup>th</sup> Street, to identify the location of existing sub-surface infrastructure and/or utilities. The information gathered from the test pits will be used to determine the location of the new catch basin.

### Community Impacts:

- “NO PARKING” 24/7 – Continues on Cooper Square West from E. 4<sup>th</sup> Street to Astor Place. *Signs have been posted.*
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Emergency Vehicle access will be maintained at all times.
- While the contractor will employ all available noise mitigation techniques, this work will entail elevated levels of noise: DDC will monitor operations to assure that they are within the DEP Noise Code regulations.
