INSTALLATION OF TRUNK WATER MAIN ON GRAND STREET PROJECT # MED 609(606)

Borough: Manhattan

October 17, 2014

WATER MAIN SHUT DOWN

NYC Department of Design + Construction & NYC DEP schedules water service interruption on **Wednesday night, October 22, 2014 from 9:30 pm to Thursday morning, October 23, 2014 approximately 5:00 am** in the following location.

- Grand Street between Bowery and Chrytie Street.

This water service interruption will facilitate to *perform the required water main work* as part of the Grand Street Project. Please ensure that the house valves (which turn the water on and off in the street) are working properly. Advance notification (outside of emergencies) will be provided for all water shut downs.

Due to impacts caused by the water service interruption, stakeholders are advised to store as much water as possible prior to the shutdown. Examples include, bath tubs, buckets, sinks, etc. DDC recommends that you shut off the main water valve in your house/building in order to avoid problems that may occur if/when sediment enters or releases from your plumbing. Such sediment may clog the screen to the water meter or make *flushometers* inoperable. You are also asked to shut off ALL water cooled appliances which *may* include industrial air conditioners, large refrigeration devices, etc. When water service is restored, turn the main house valve back on and flush the system by running your faucets into sinks and tubs for a few minutes.
