Please Do Not Wash Sidewalk or Roadway

South Side of Grand St, Lafayette St to Bowery
Including Intersections

**Scheduled for: Wednesday, 9/3/14 to Thursday, 9/4/14
7:00 am – 5:00 pm**

Please be advised beginning on/about Wednesday, September 3, 2014 through Thursday, September 4, 2014, from 7:00am to approximately 5:00pm (*weather and field conditions permitting*), access to loading docks, curbside parking and **washing sidewalk will be restricted** along South Side of Grand Street from Lafayette Street intersection through Bowery. These impacts are associated with the Bike Lane restoration, performed by the New York City Department of Design and Construction (DDC). These are mobile operations with work from Lafayette Street to Bowery (including all the intersections except Bowery.) During work hours, vehicular traffic may experience intermittent delays. Flaggers will be on site during working hours to aid with pedestrian and motorist safety.

TRAFFIC/COMMUNITY IMPACTS:

- Please refrain from Washing Sidewalks during this period
- Vehicular traffic may experience intermittent delays during work hours scheduled from 7am to approximately 5pm.
- “No Parking” restrictions will be in effect and “No Parking” signs will be posted by the Contractor throughout the affected area. Vehicles parked in “No Parking” zones, will be towed by the Contractor. Contact the CCL or the 5th Precinct for the towing list.
- Emergency vehicle and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- If you have a scheduled delivery, please contact this office to determine whether it can be accommodated.
