<b>Operation 4</b> Location	<b>Waterworks Will Continue to Assist Con-Ed for the New 12" Gas Mains Excavations</b> On South side sidewalk of Grand Street between Mulberry and Baxter Streets
<b>Operation 5</b> Location	<b>Support Con-Ed with the Fabrication and the Installation of the New 12" Gas Main</b> On Mulberry Street Between Hester and Broome Streets
