PLANYC 2030 includes initiatives for transportation, housing, parks, air quality, and more. Transit capacity initiatives include congestion pricing, and others to be financed by a new regional transit financing authority. Initiatives to make housing more affordable include creative financing and inclusionary zoning. Open space initiatives include creating new or enhanced public plazas to ensure everyone is a 10-minute walk from a park. Green initiatives would clean up all contaminated land and achieve the cleanest air of any big city.
