

Draft Resolutions for CB3 Transportation Committee

Thursday November 6, 2014

Community Access and 200 community members ask Community Board 3 to contact NYC Department of Transportation to demand traffic calming measures near Gouverneur Slip and Water Street.

This area presents a traffic safety issue for people who are physically disabled, seniors and high school students who cross this street on a daily basis.

This Street is one short block away from the East Side Highway and cars speed down the block in question. The yield sign at Water Street is never up as cars and trucks knock the sign down and now the sign is obscured by construction.

123 people in one building Gouverneur Court must cross that street every time they want to get to and from their home. Many people cross this street to get to the Pier directly behind Gouverneur Court building. There is also a playground across the street along with several apartment buildings with hundreds of apartments run by NYCHA.

1. Be it resolved that Community Board 3 will urge NYC Department of Transportation to install a traffic light on the Northeast corner of Gouverneur Slip West and Water Street.
